

PhD Studentships in the Sensors Group

A PhD candidate is required to join the Sensors Group at Cranfield Defence and Security at the Defence Academy of the United Kingdom in Shrivenham.

The project is aimed at research into the image processing techniques that may be used by infrared imaging seekers and the development of the modelling and simulation of infrared imaging seekers. This work will also look at techniques and developments in support of countermeasures to imaging seeker systems.
