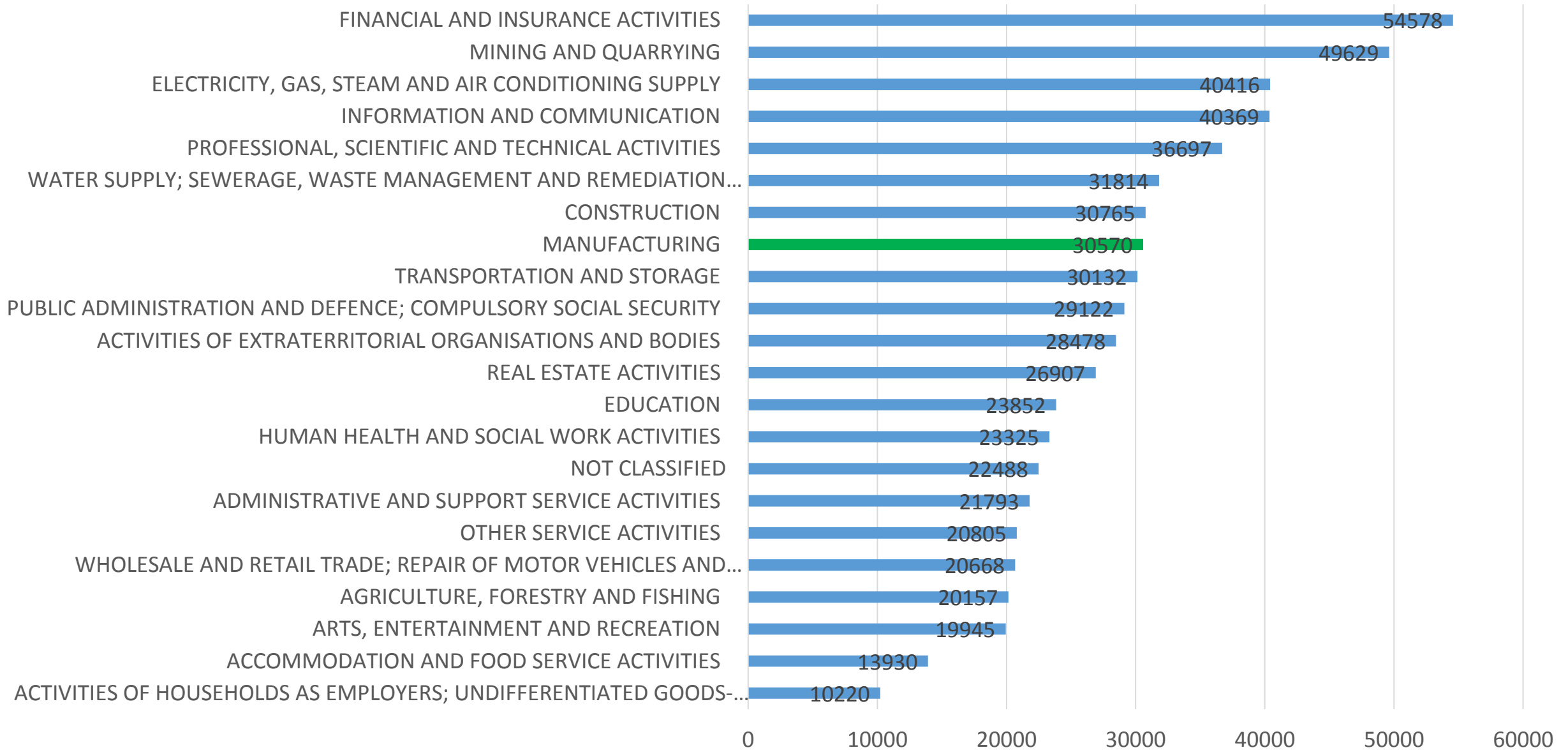
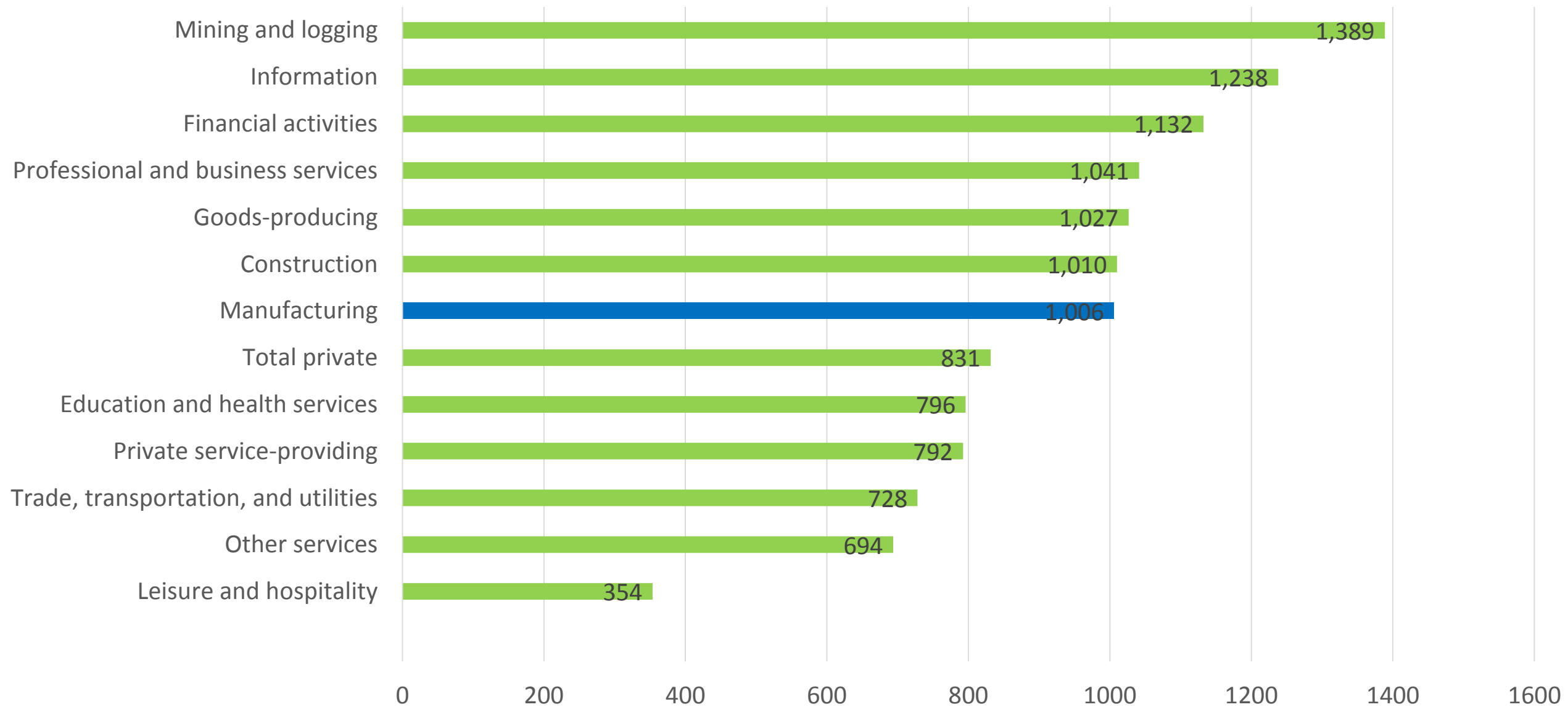


Annual average income - Gross (£) - For all employee jobs: United Kingdom, 2013



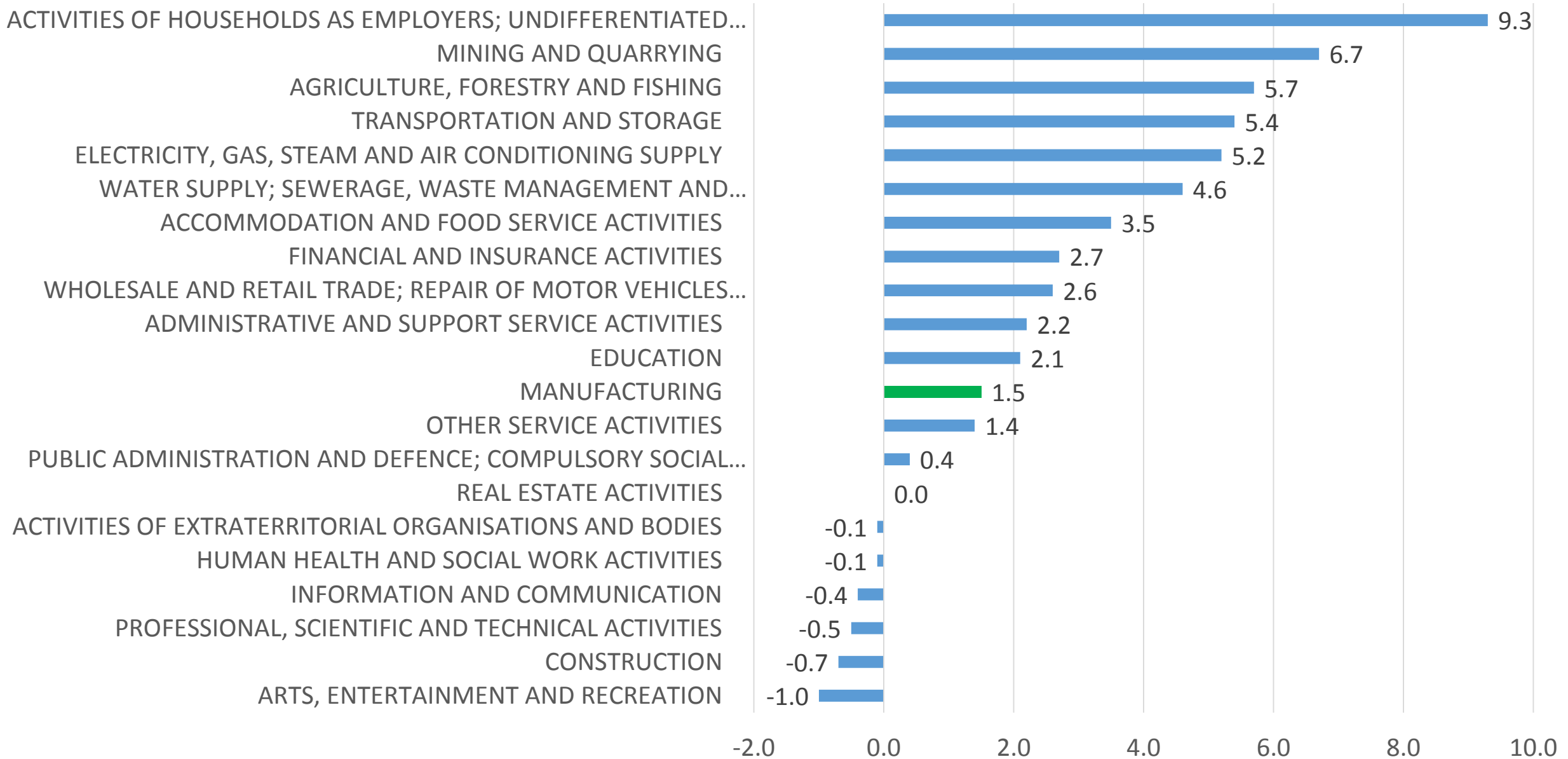

Average weekly earnings of all employees on private nonfarm payrolls by industry sector, seasonally adjusted, \$, US, 2014

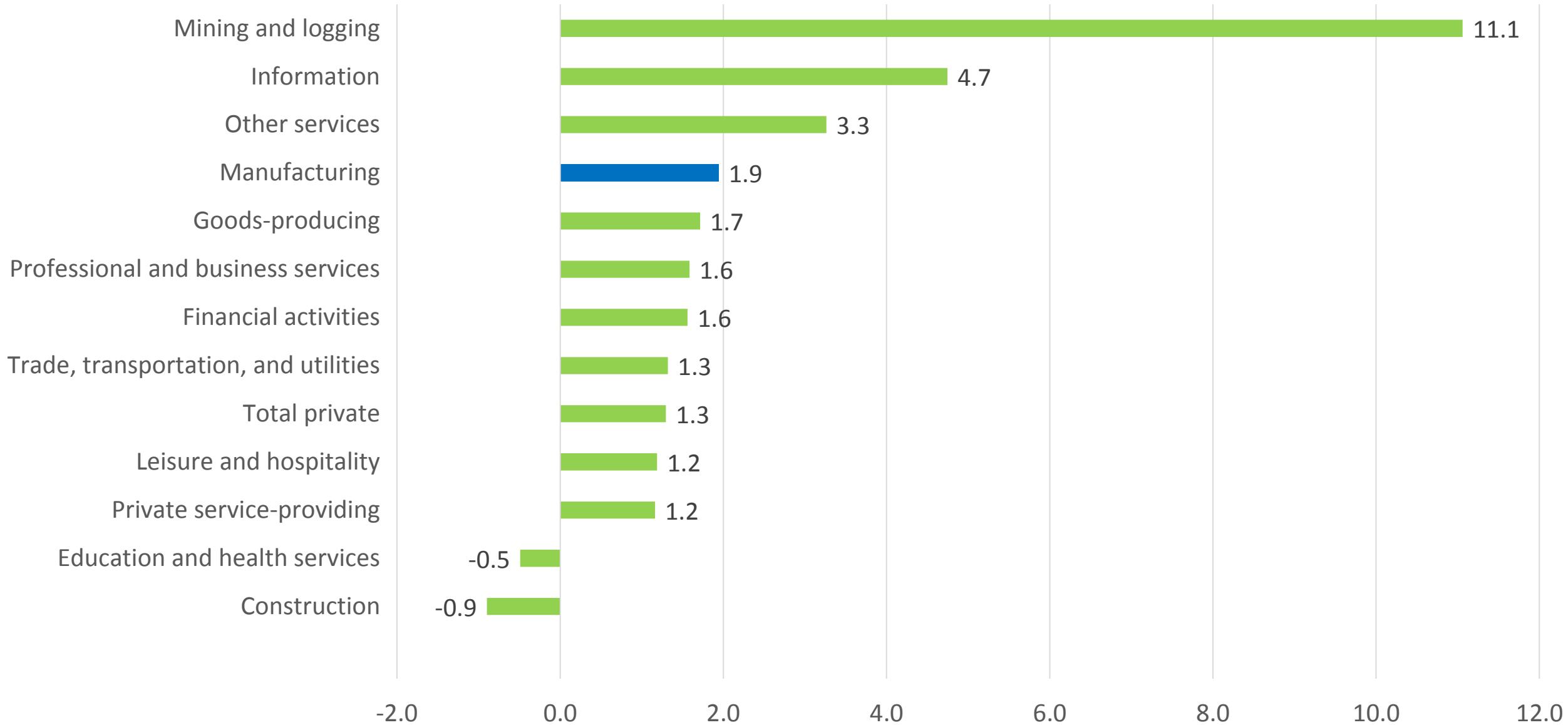

Average weekly earnings growth of all employees on private nonfarm payrolls by industry sector, seasonally adjusted, %, US, 2014

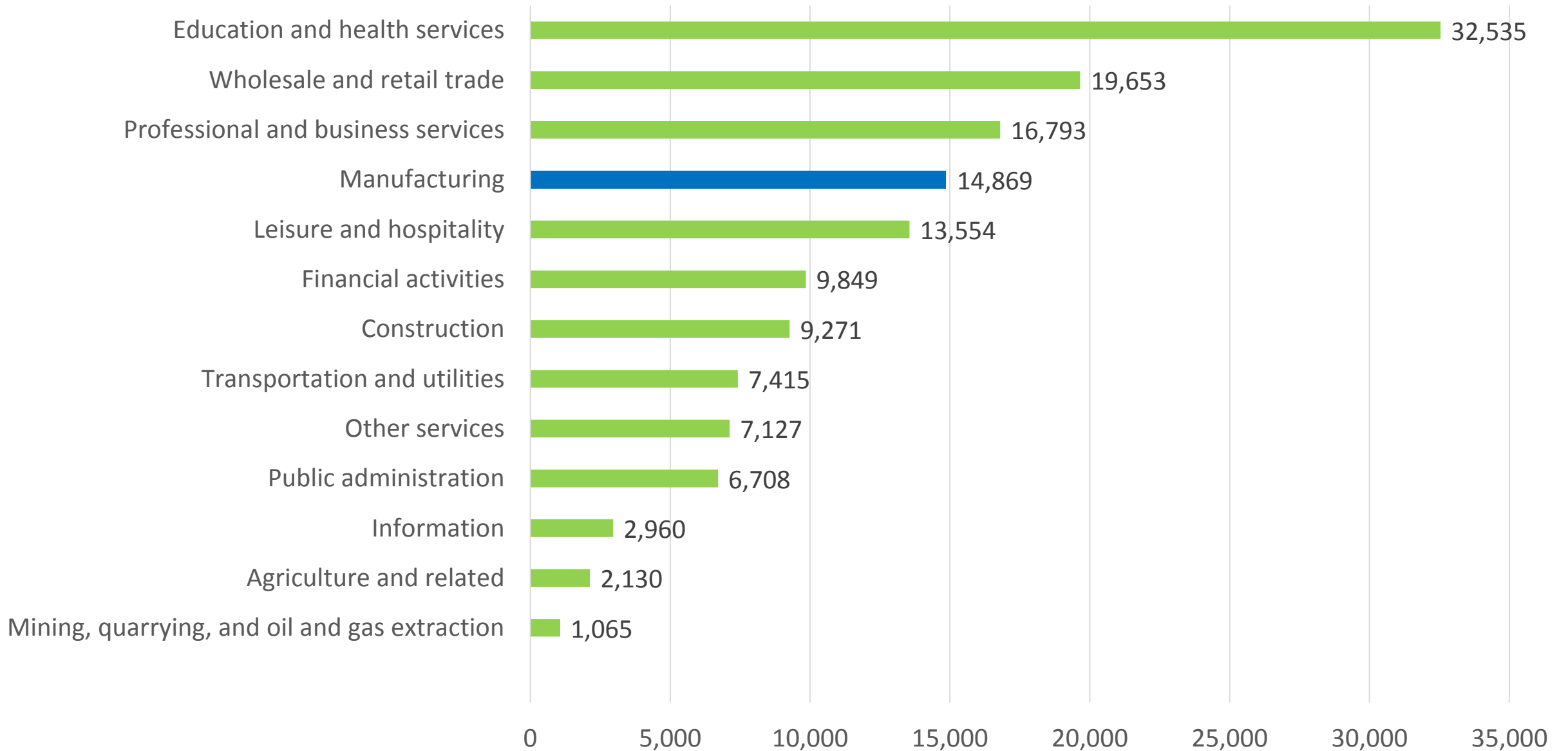

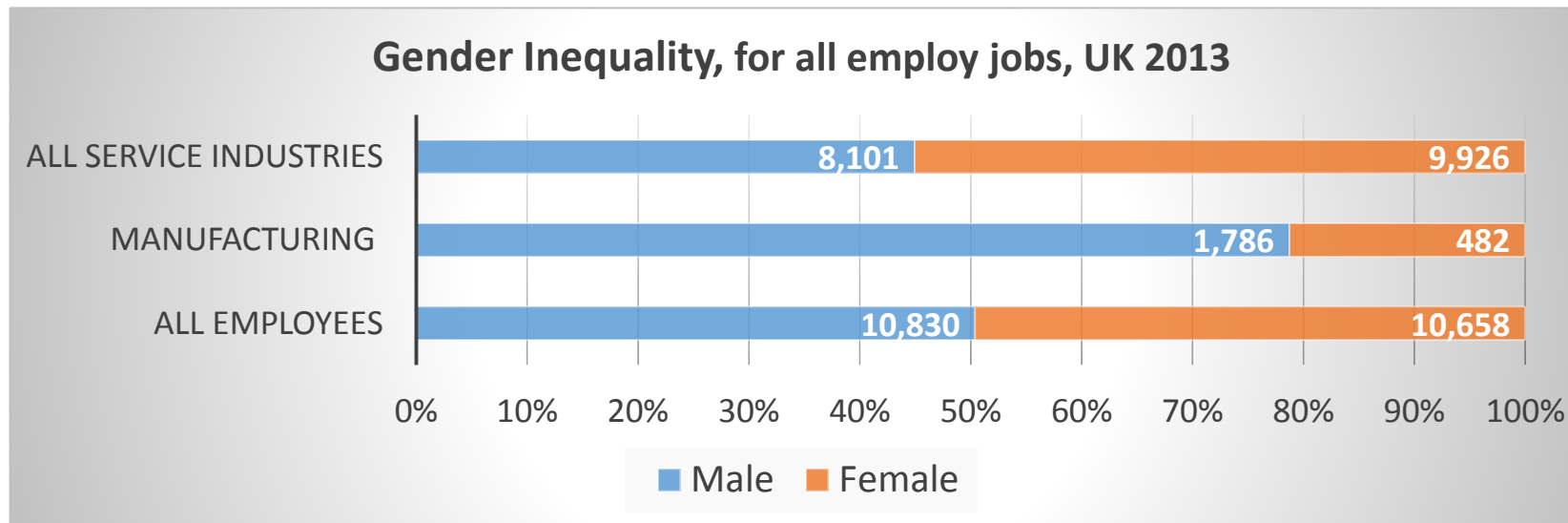
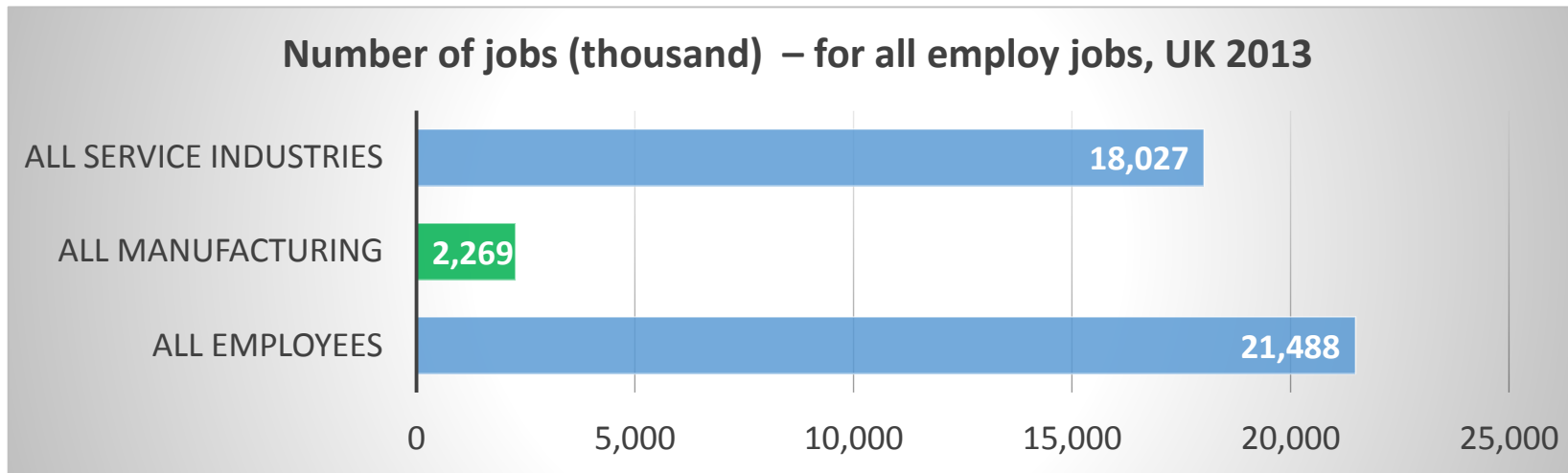
Number of jobs (thousand) – for all employ jobs, UK 2013



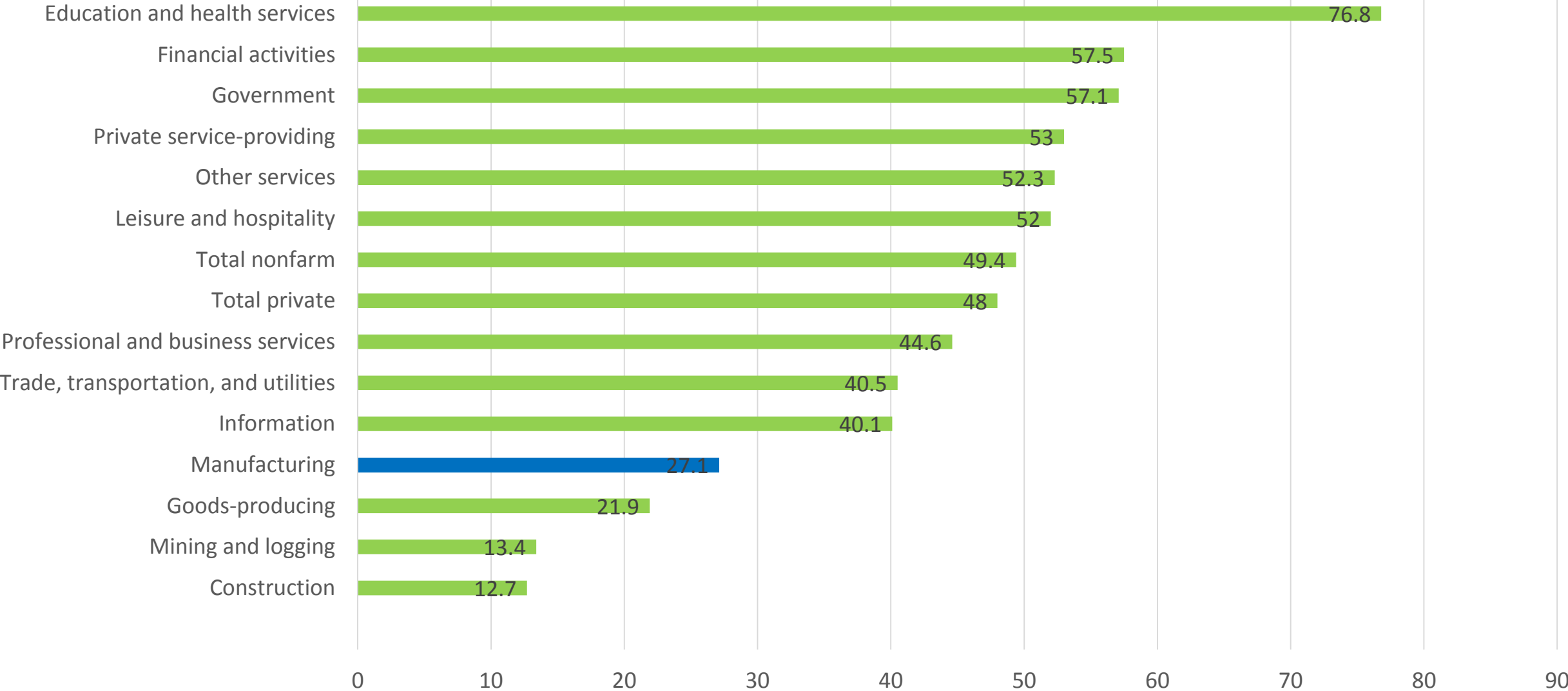
Employed persons by industry, US, 2013, (thousand)

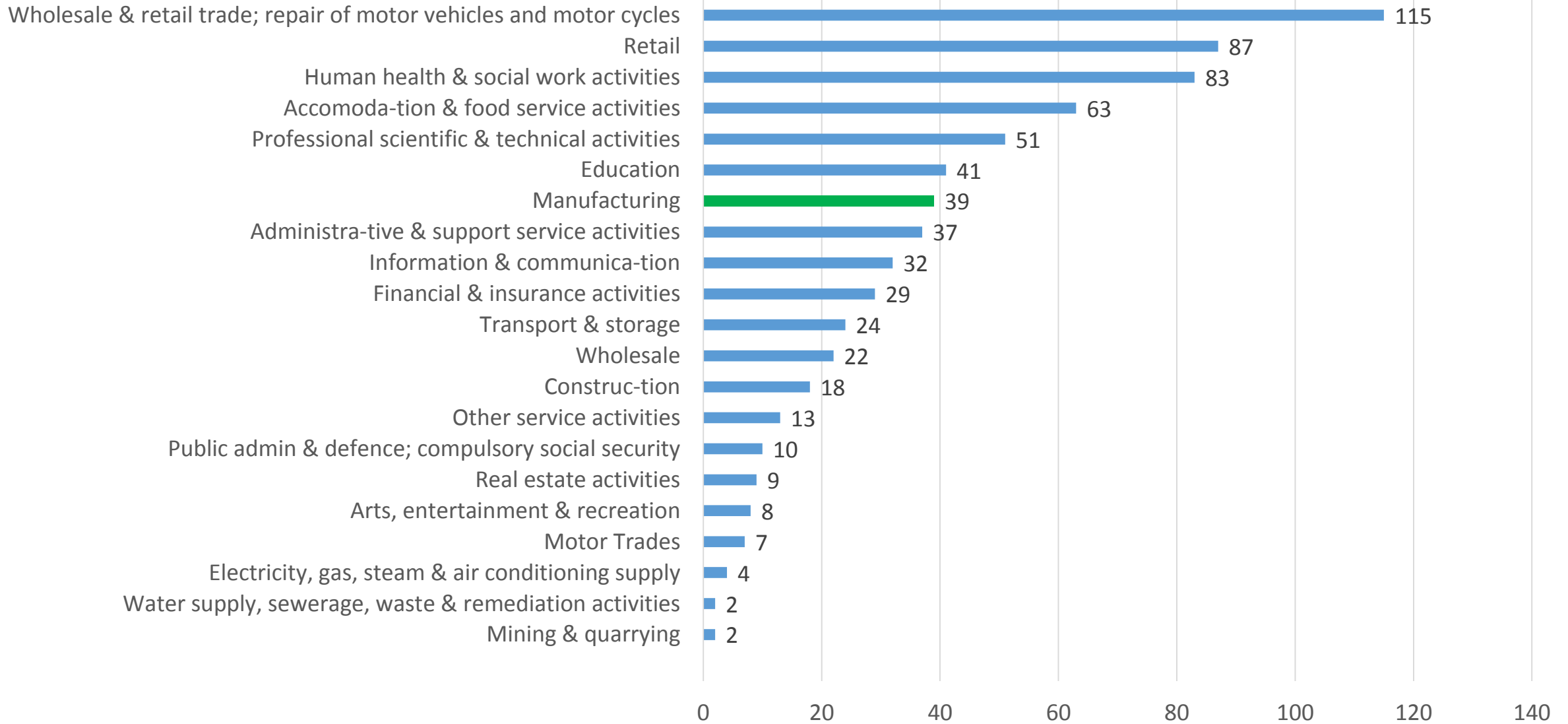


Percentage of all employment of women on nonfarm payrolls by industry sector, seasonally adjusted, US, 2014



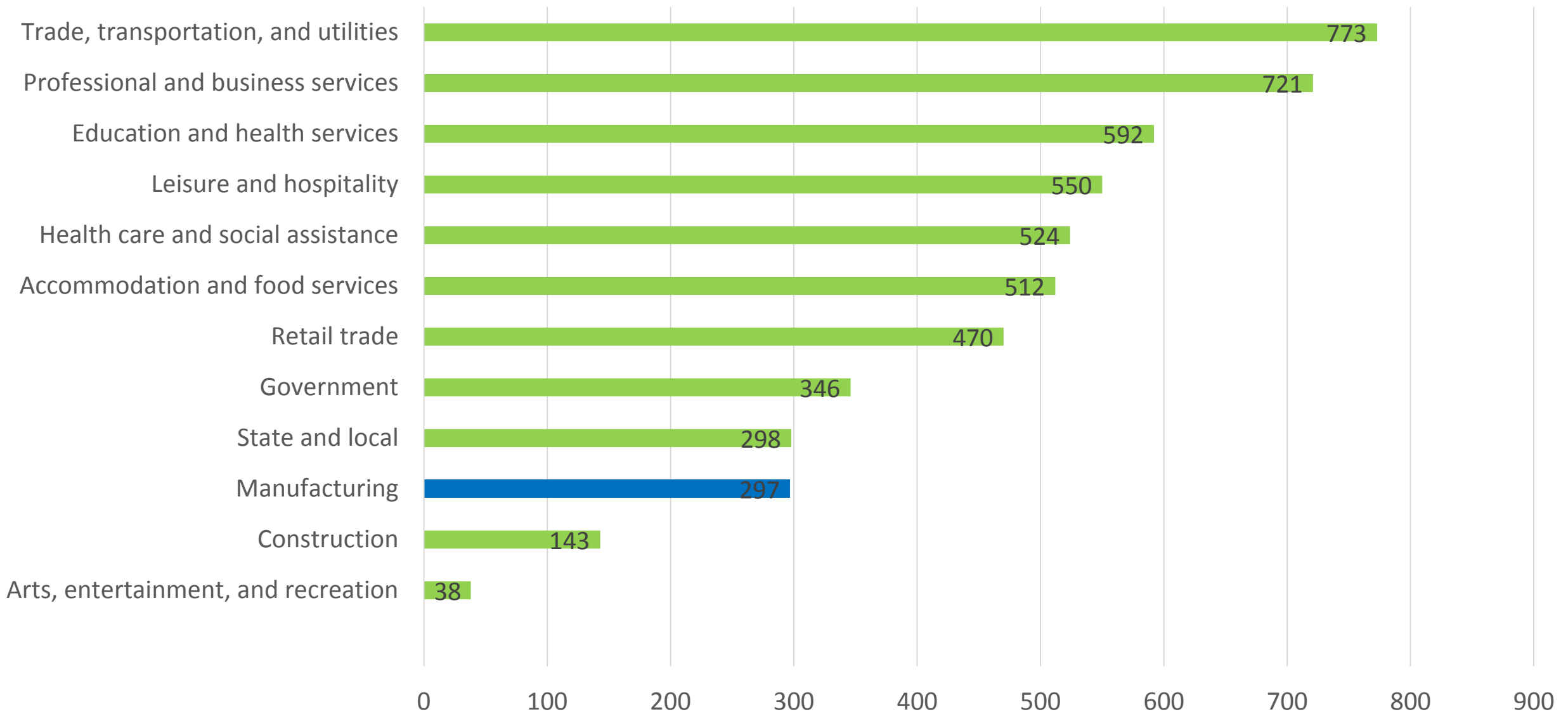

Vacancies by industry – UK - Nov-Jan 2014 (thousand)



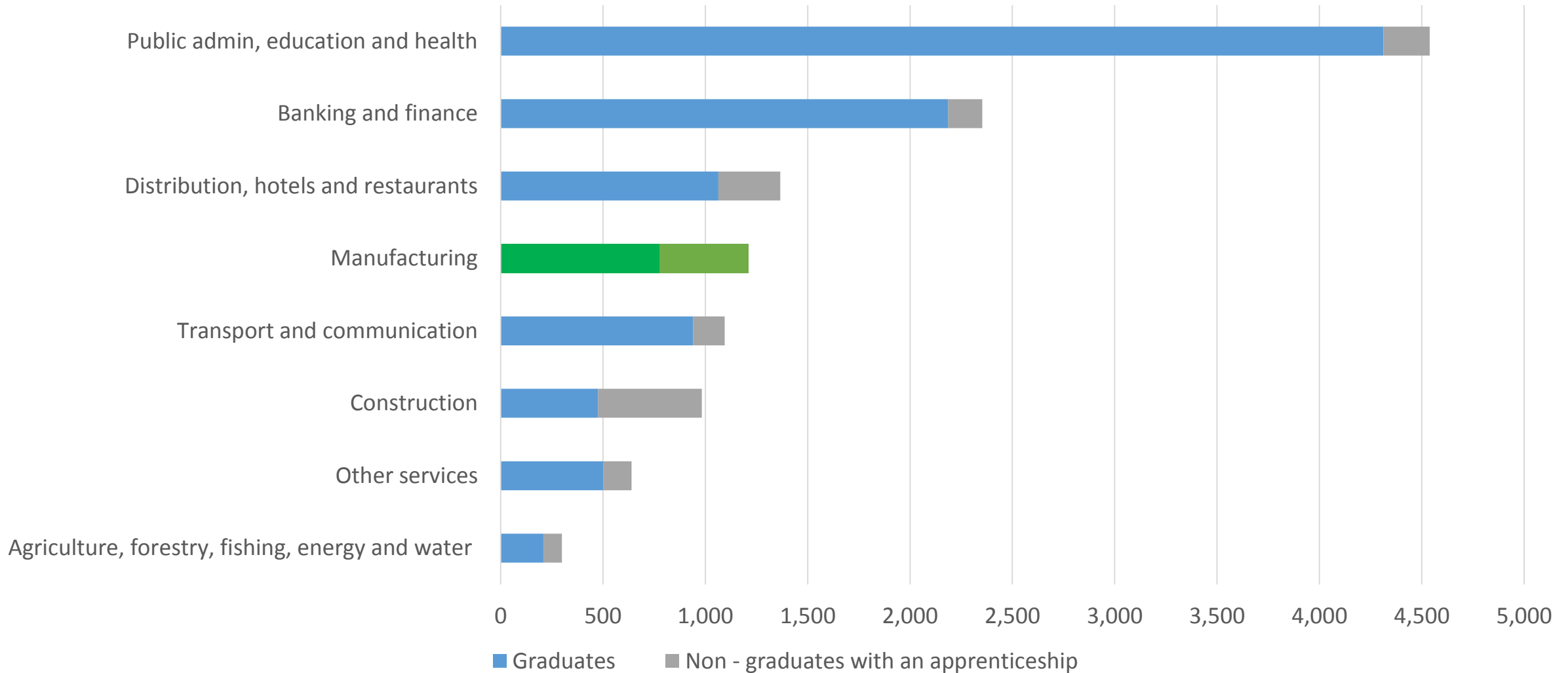

Vacancies by industry sector, US, Dec. 2013, (thousand)



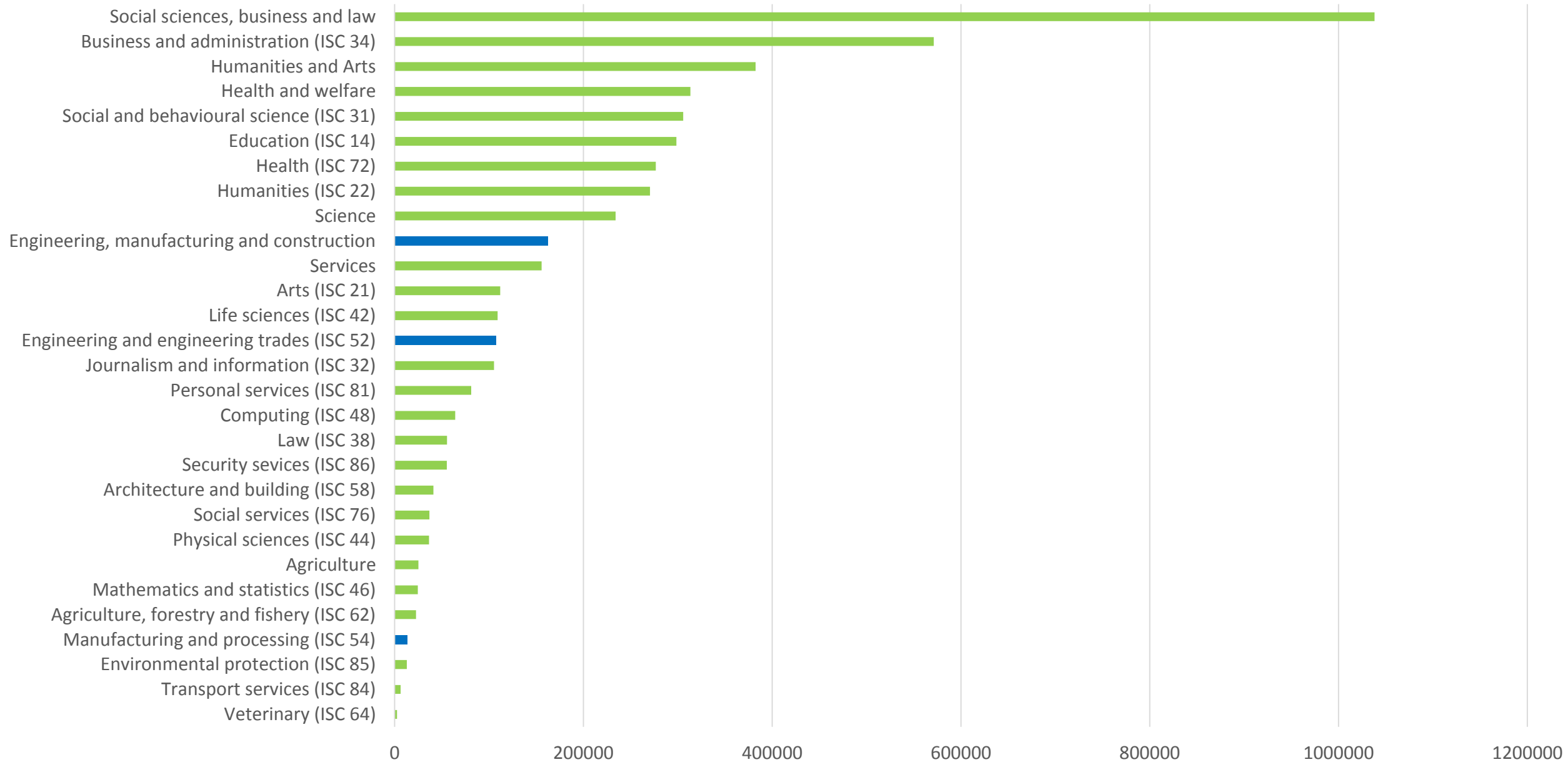

The number of employed graduates and employed non-graduates who have completed an apprenticeship – UK – 2013 (thousand)

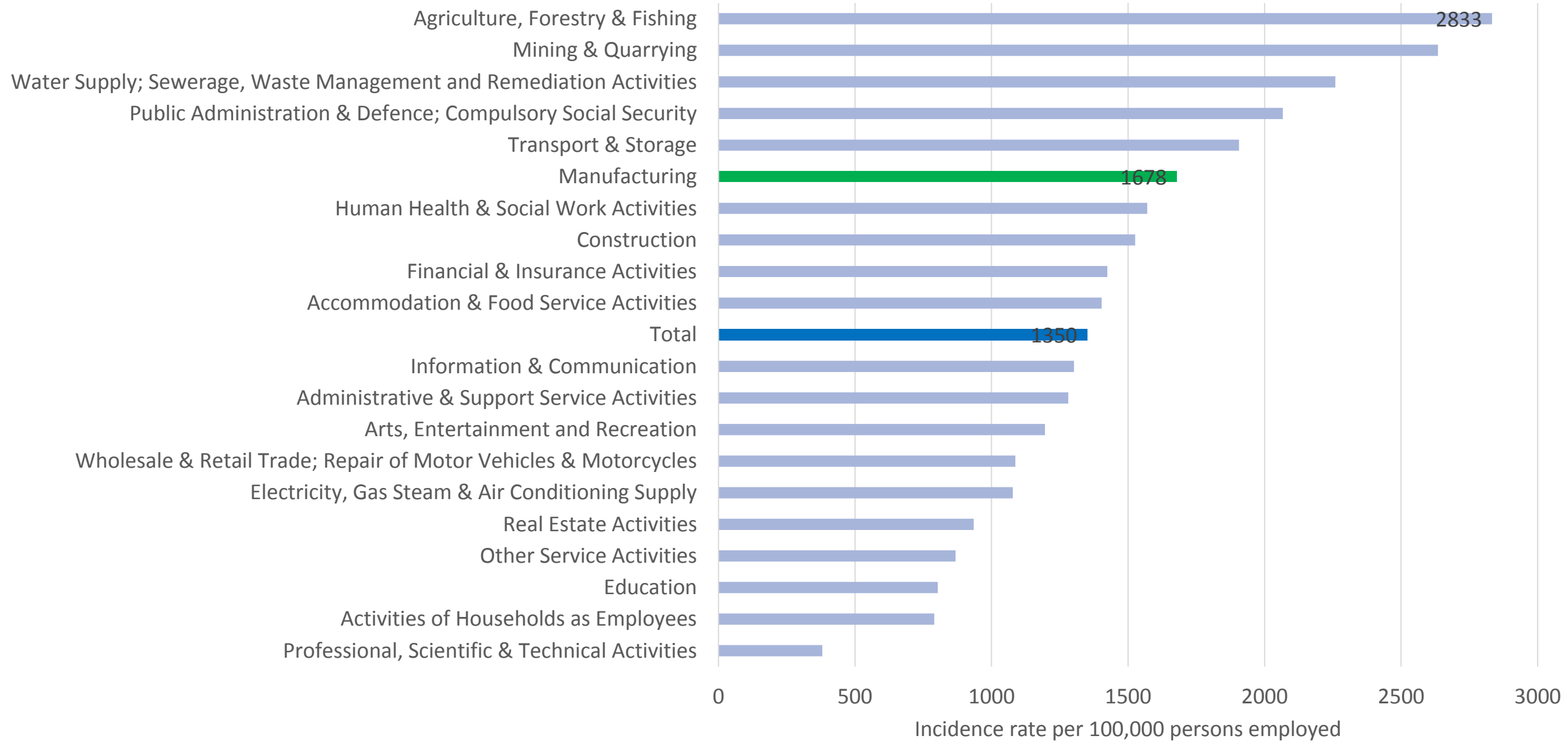

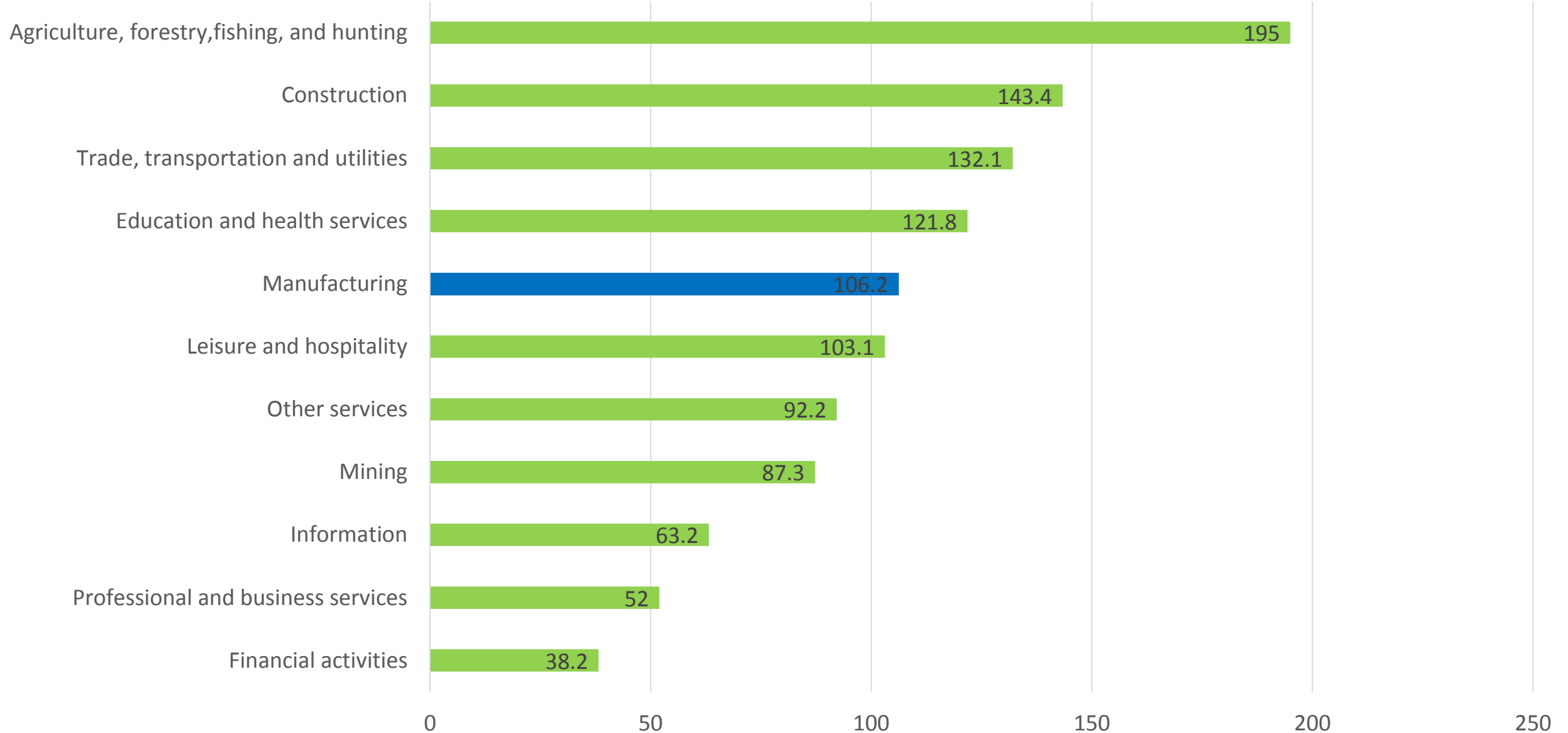
Tertiary and advanced research programmes graduate by field of education, US, 2014



Incidence of work-related ill-health - UK – Avg 2010 - 2012

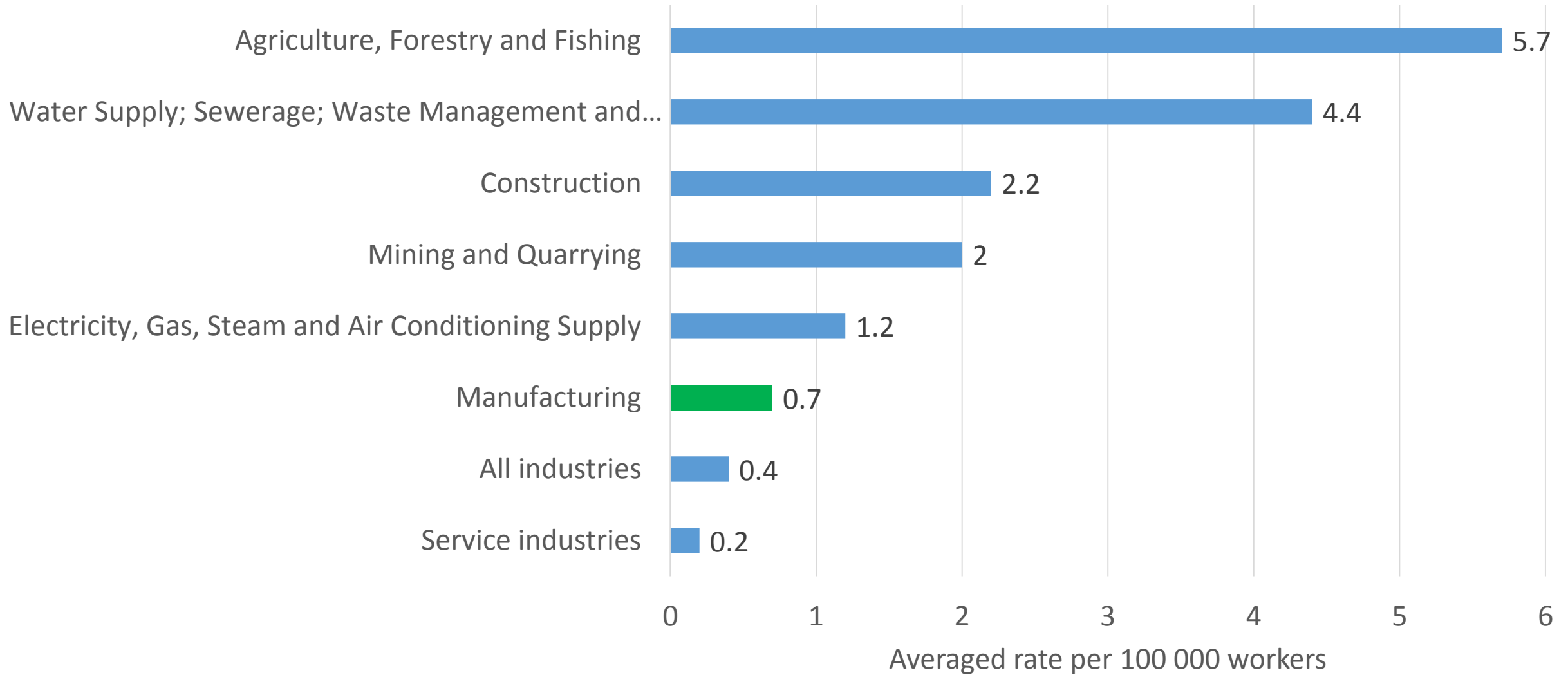


Incidence rate for nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses, US, 2012, per 10,000 full-time worker



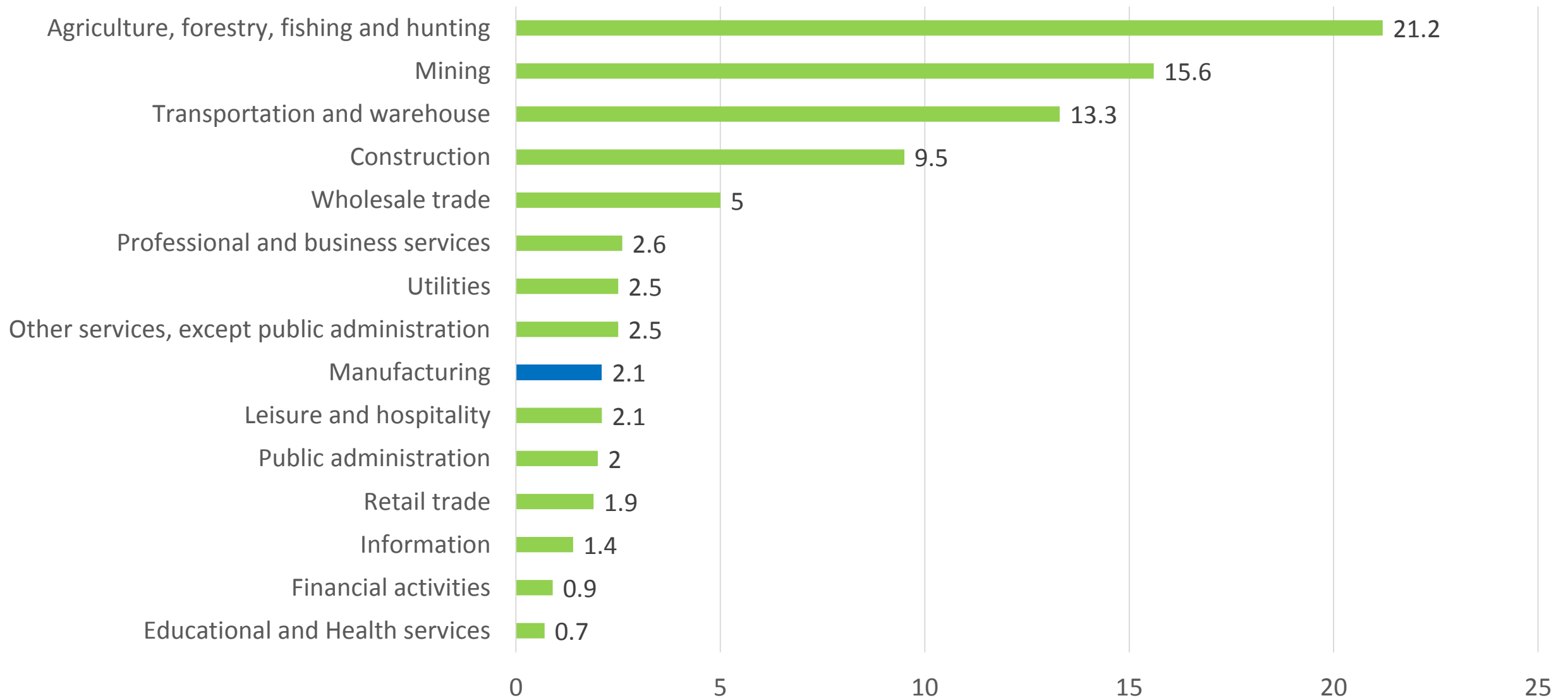

Reported employee fatal injury - UK - 2012-13



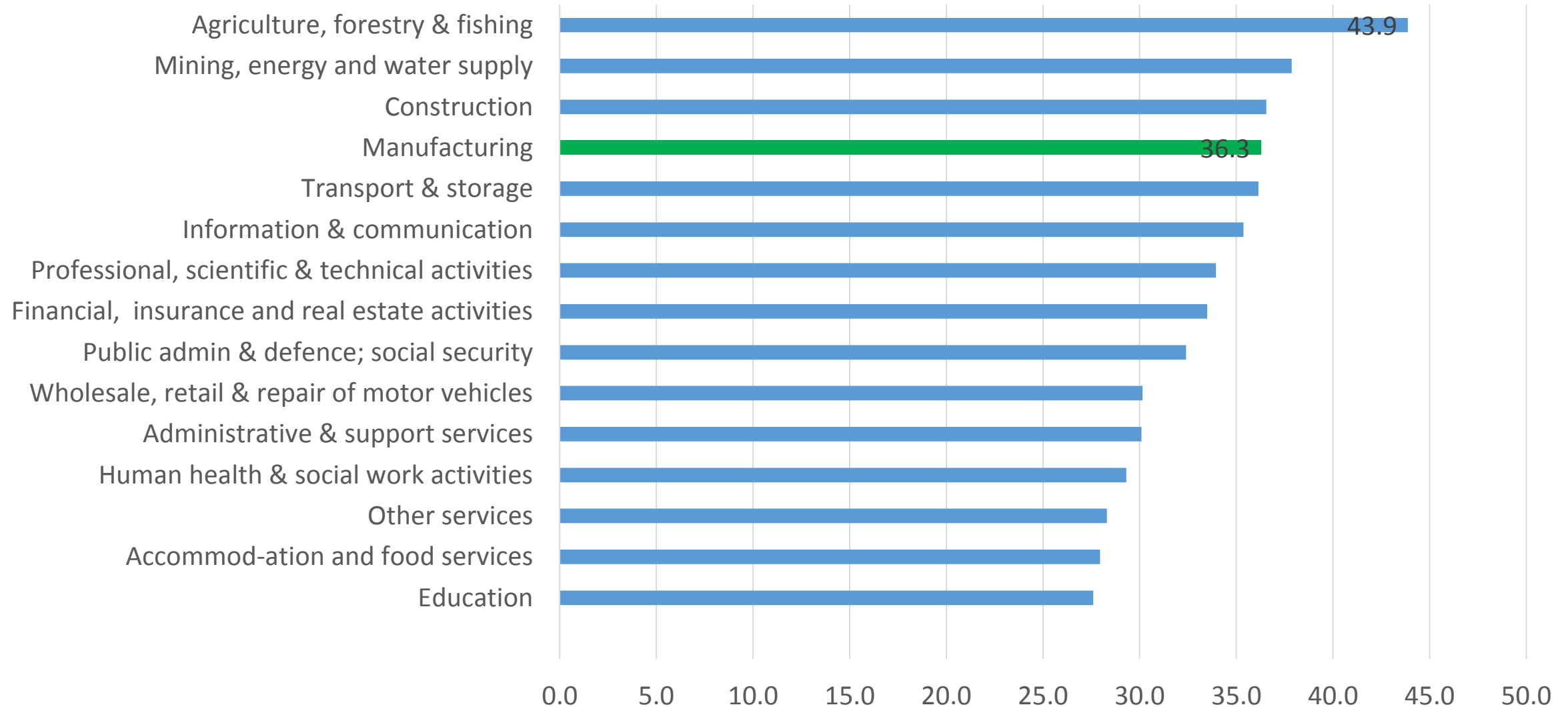

Rate of fatal occupational injuries, US, 2012, per 10,000 full-time workers

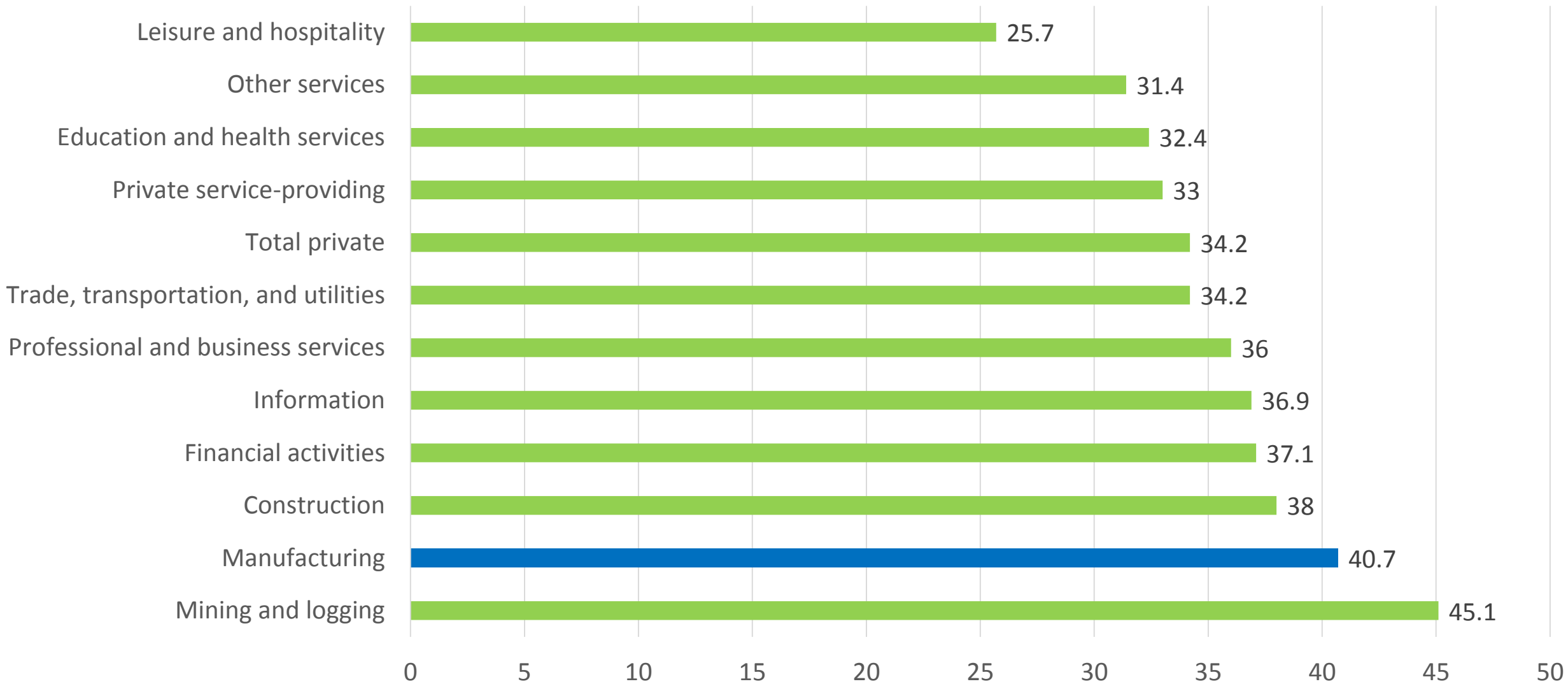

Average actual weekly hours per worker by Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) 2007 (not seasonally adjusted)

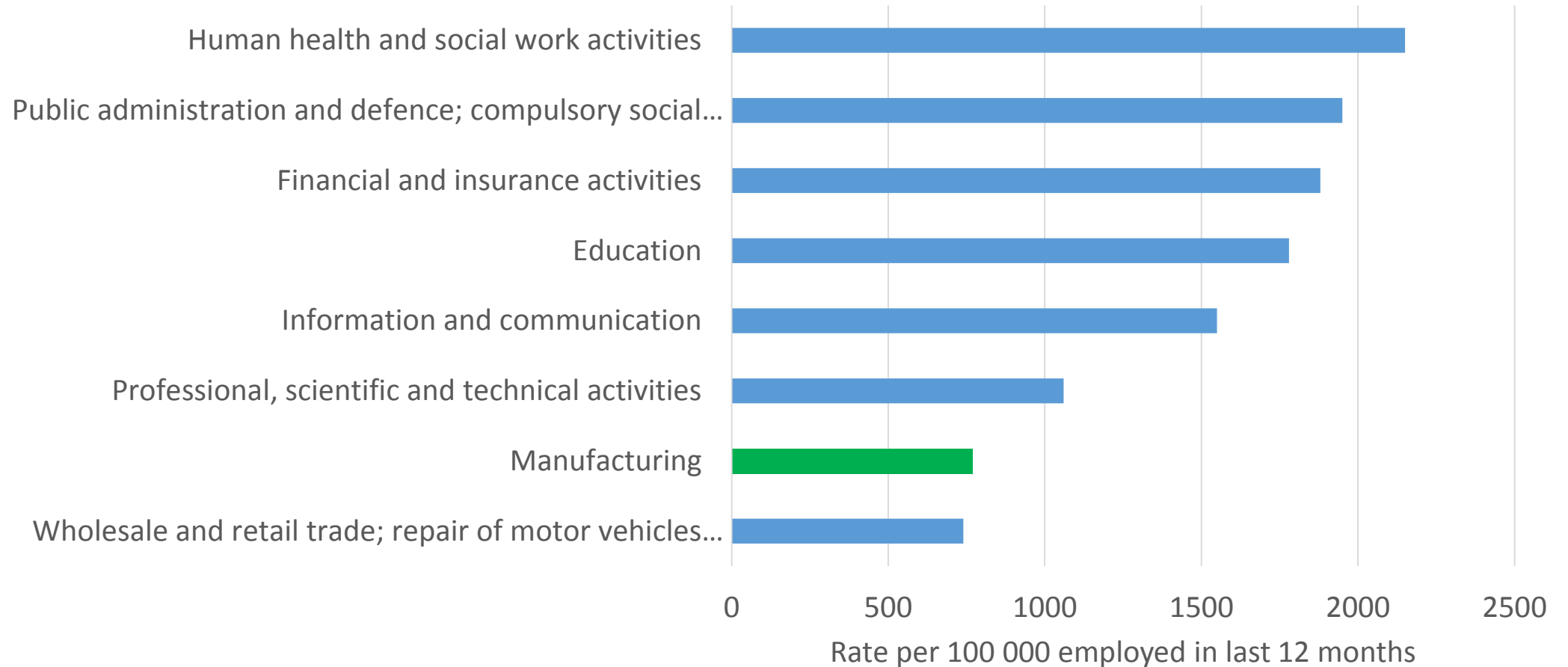


Average weekly hours and overtime of all employees on private nonfarm payrolls by industry sector, seasonally adjusted, US, 2014



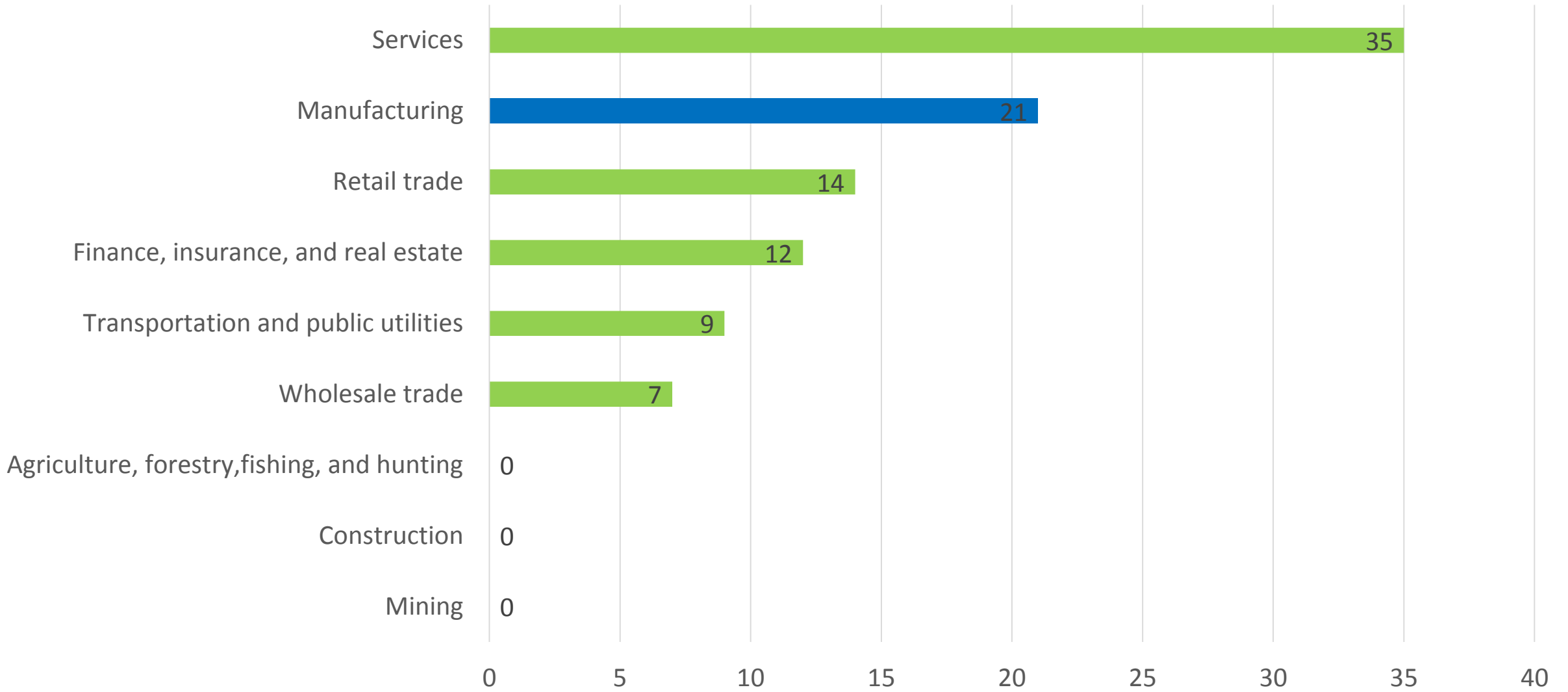
