Registration

If you registered on-line, you will still need to go to the Registry desk for stage 2 of the registration process. You are required to bring your **passport** for verification.

Site Passes

Main Reception (SN6 8TS) will issue arriving postgraduate students with **temporary passes** and car passes, valid for your initial visit on site. These must be upgraded to **permanent passes** before your temporary pass expires.

When applying for your permanent pass you should produce official photographic ID and your Registration Document.

Vehicle passes should be displayed whilst on site and placed out of sight on departure.

Students holding MOD90 cards are not required to collect permanent passes.
