This short course will illustrate how nature-based solutions can contribute to deliver sustainable land and water management. You will acquire the skills to identify, evaluate, and perform feasibility designs of different nature-based water management approaches and technologies in urban and rural environments.

There are eight modules organised around a central topic. The activities are a combination of research, introspection, creative design, non-technical writing and online quizzes. In addition, you must hand in a final assignment. The estimated total time for the course is 60 hours (6 CPD credits).
