- Psychometric test practice and case study interview examples.
- Access to Symplicity to view hundreds of job opportunities, book career appointments, workshops and events, upload multiple CVs and use the mock interview tool.
- Career development workshops on topics such as completing application forms, interviews and assessment centres, online and face-to-face networking.

- Opportunities to meet relevant recruiters and employers invited to Cranfield for bespoke presentations and careers fairs.
