Here's how you can help:

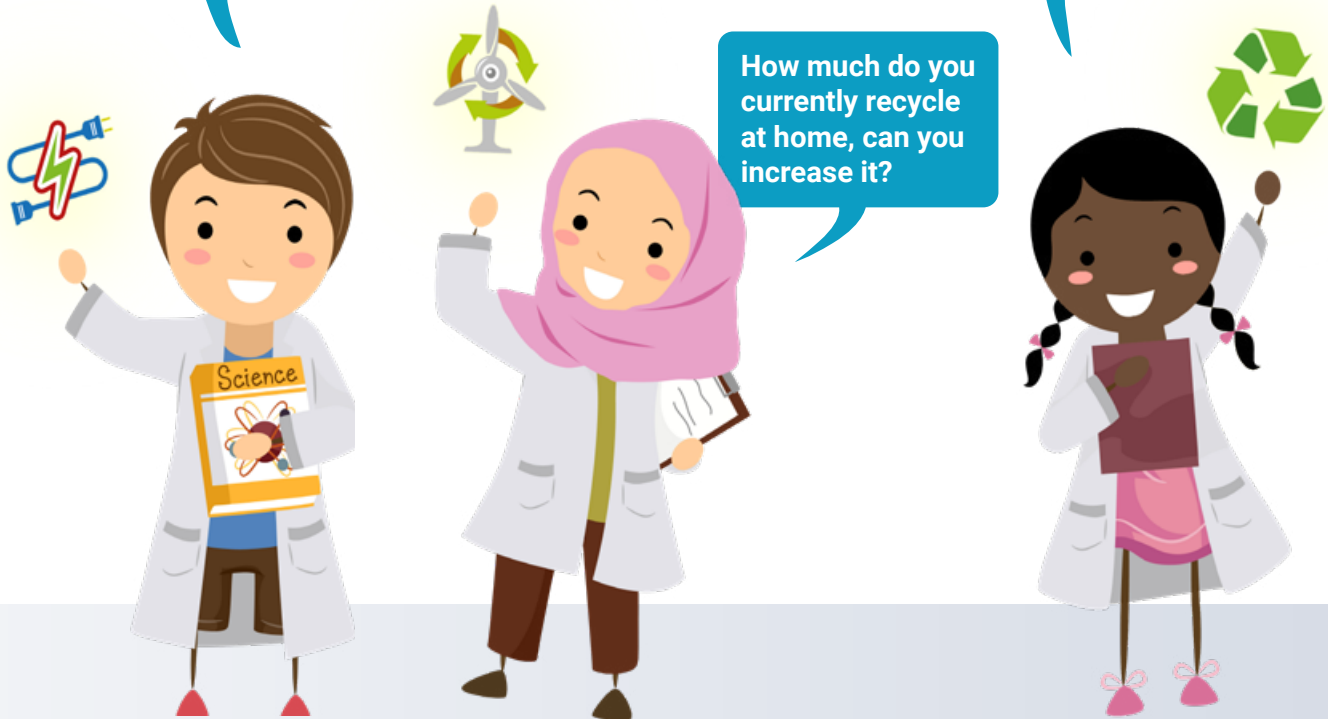
- Talk to your parents or carers about what you can do to help at home.
