Where do I find apprenticeship vacancies at Cranfield University?

Apprenticeship vacancies are advertised on our website throughout the year and are posted once we have an apprenticeship vacancy available.

Where do I apply for an Apprenticeship at Cranfield University?

Occasionally, applications are managed by our training provider partners. If this is the case, you will be directed to their application process from the website above

What is the application process?

Initially you will need to complete an application form and you may need to have a short eligibility interview with our training provider to check you are eligible for apprenticeship funding. If shortlisted, you will be invited for an interview with us at Cranfield University. As part of this interview, you may need to undertake a simple test which is appropriate to the apprenticeship role and you may be offered a tour of the work area.

If you are successful, you will hear from us with an offer of employment.

What are the entry requirements for an apprenticeship at Cranfield?

Specific entry requirements are included in our apprenticeship vacancy details. However, most of our apprenticeship vacancies are Level 3 (equivalent to A levels). Our minimum entry requirements for a Level 3 apprenticeship at Cranfield is GCSE pass grades of 4 or above in Maths and English. If the role is a technical/engineering role, we will also be looking for a GCSE pass grade of 4 or above in a science subject.

Do you offer degree apprenticeships?

Yes. These are also advertised on our website but may have higher entry requirements and which will be specified in the candidate pack.

What is the ratio of work and study?

All apprenticeships involve a minimum of 20% off the job training (approximately 1 day a week). Study commitments can vary depending on the level and type of apprenticeship but may involve physical attendance at the training provider's premises or completing blended/online learning. You will be informed of the expected study commitments at interview.

Do you offer open days for apprentices or tours?

We do not host specific apprenticeship open days but we do offer tours (where possible) as part of our interview experience should you be successful in being invited to interview.
