The Summer Internship Programme 2024-25

A period of **full-time** work starting on the **7th of July 2025** and lasting between **8 to 12 weeks** where MBA candidates work on relevant **strategic projects and assignments** that give them an opportunity to synthesise relevant concepts and methods learned on the MBA and apply their learning to **real business situations**.

The final deliverables can be in the form of reports, presentations, slide decks, dashboards etc, agreed in advance between students and companies.





If you are willing to pay the students, Cranfield can pay the student on your behalf via bursary and invoice you for the student's payment + VAT. The amount suggested is £4k per student, and it relates to the whole duration of the 8 week internship (or 12 weeks pro-rata).


You can pay the student directly via your payroll using our internship agreement.

If you are unable to pay the students, we can advertise unpaid projects, however, paid projects remain the most popular and usually get the best quality students.

For unpaid projects, we request for travel expenses to be covered if required.

Projects can be in-person, hybrid and remote. Onsite and hybrid projects remain the most popular with students.
