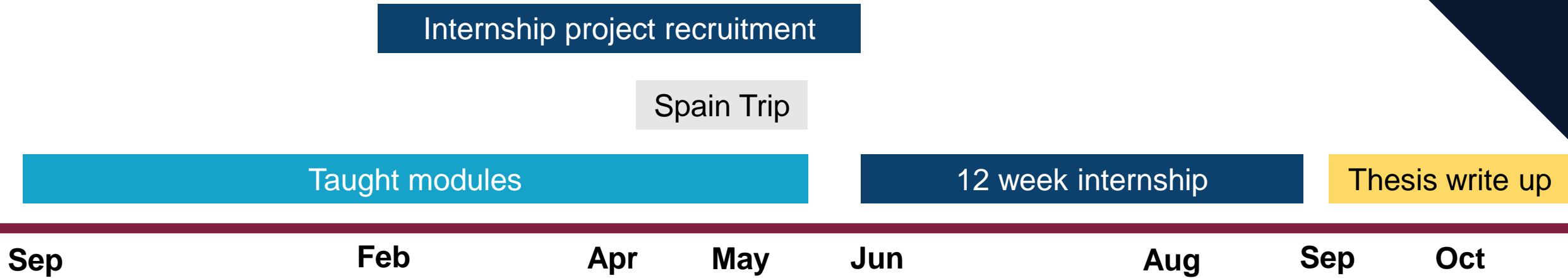

Thesis

Students must write a thesis of around 7,000 words which is **informed by academic and practitioner literature** and written in **report style with recommendations** and/or learning points. This is usually based on their internship projects. We can coordinate confidentiality agreements if required.

All students are allocated a **leading academic supervisor** who will support them throughout the process. During the internship period, students will work on their thesis in their spare time.



Thesis submission deadline in October following the internship project.

Payments and Mode of Work

If you are willing to pay the students, Cranfield can pay the student on your behalf via bursary and invoice you for the student's payment. We suggest £4k + VAT. This amount relates to the whole duration of the 12 week internship.

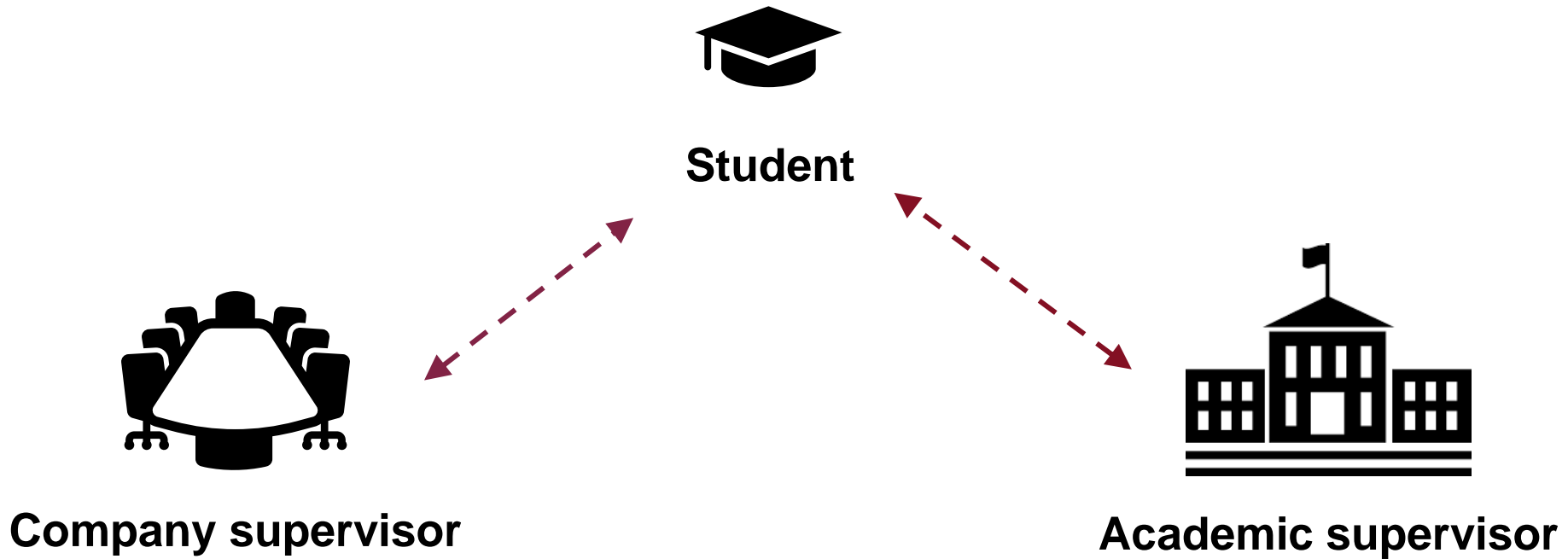
Alternatively, you can pay the student directly via your payroll, supported with our internship agreement.

If you are unable to pay the students, we can advertise unpaid projects, however, paid projects remain the most popular and usually get the best quality students.

For unpaid projects, we request for travel expenses to be covered if required.

Projects can be in-person, hybrid and remote. Onsite and hybrid projects remain the most popular with students.
