

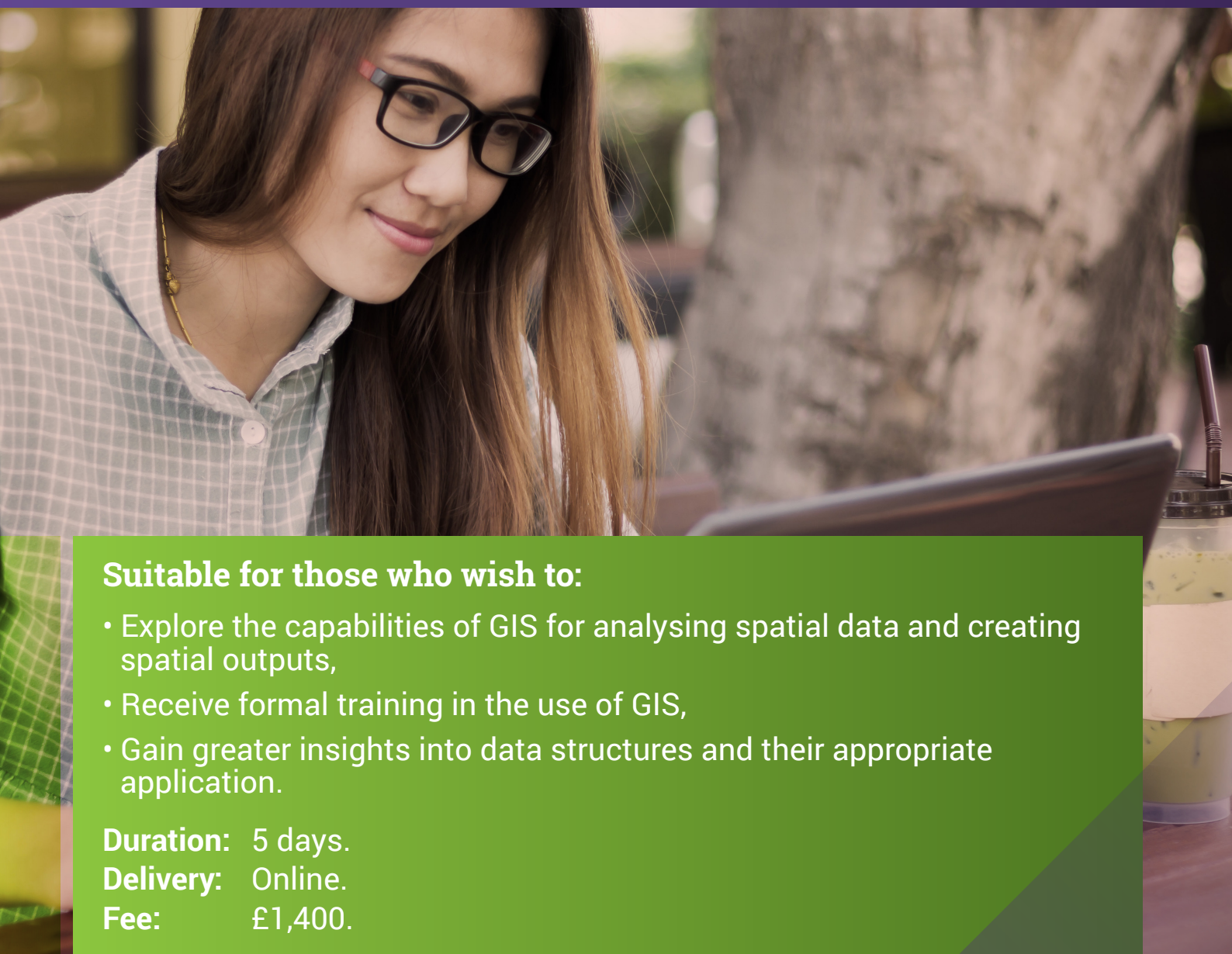


GIS Fundamentals
