Initial Assessment

If you're unsure if you're eligible to apply for the Full-time MBA programme, complete the pre-application **Eligibility Check** on our website to receive feedback from our Recruitment Team.

Keview by Selection Committee

We run a staged application process, so all applications are reviewed together at this point. Your application must be complete (including the receipt of all necessary supporting documents) before it can be considered.

Your submitted application will be reviewed by the Selection Committee, and you'll be informed within two weeks of the deadline whether you have been shortlisted for an interview. You will be sent a link to book an interview slot via the application portal. At this stage, you will also be invited to apply for one of our scholarships.

You can start your application via the **Apply Now** link on the website. This will take you through to the application portal, where you will create an account before starting your application. This can be saved and revisited before final submission. As part of the application form, you will be required to upload your supporting documents such as final degree certificate, transcript, and GMAT/GRE score report. You can also upload your references (on official headed paper, signed by the referee and dated within the past 12 months) or we will contact them on your behalf.



Once all interviews have taken place, the Admissions Board will consider the interviewer's feedback alongside your initial application and scholarship request. We aim to inform applicants of our decision within three weeks of their interview date.

Currently, all interviews are conducted via Zoom but we do intend to return to face-to-face interviews shortly for those able to travel to Cranfield. Your interview will either be with the Programme Director, a member of Faculty or our Alumni Ambassador and takes approximately 30 minutes. You will be required to give an informal three-minute presentation and you will be sent the topic beforehand.

The initial offer is called a conditional offer. You will be asked to inform us of your decision within one month. If you accept your offer, you will be required to pay a deposit of $\pm 3,000$. You will have a further month to meet any outstanding conditions such as an English language proficiency test. Your offer needs to be unconditional before we can start the CAS process for those needing a visa to study in the UK.

Preparation
